FEMA Information for 3/08/16 Flood

- President Obama officially declared a major disaster for Louisiana as a result of flooding and severe storms that began on March 8, 2016.
- The president's action makes federal funding available to affected individuals in seven parishes: **Bossier, Claiborne, Grant, Morehouse, Ouachita, Richland and Webster.**
- Assistance can include grants for **temporary housing** and **home repairs**, **low-cost loans** to cover **uninsured property losses**, and **other programs** to help individuals and business owners recover from the effects of the disaster.
- Individuals and business owners who sustained losses in the designated area can begin applying for assistance March 14th by registering online at **www.DisasterAssistance.gov**.
